Berkenaan dengan adanya informasi dari ASEA-UNINET Network Office mengenai pembukaan Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET (Call 2027/2028), bersama ini kami sampaikan informasi tersebut untuk dapat disebarluaskan kepada dosen, peneliti, tenaga kependidikan, serta mahasiswa di lingkungan fakultas masing-masing.

Program Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET merupakan program beasiswa yang didanai oleh OeAD (Austria's Agency for Education and Internationalisation) untuk mendukung:

- Program studi penuh jenjang Doktor (Full PhD);
- Kegiatan penelitian pascadoktoral (Postdoctoral Research Stay); dan
- Program praktik musik (Music Practice Stay) di Austria.

Adapun beberapa informasi penting terkait program tersebut adalah sebagai berikut:

1. Periode pendaftaran dibuka mulai 15 September 2026 dan ditutup pada 1 Maret 2027.
2. Aplikasi dilakukan secara daring melalui laman grants.at.
3. Topik penelitian terbuka untuk seluruh disiplin ilmu, dengan ketentuan proposal harus menunjukkan relevansi penelitian bagi Austria dan negara anggota ASEAN.
4. Pelamar program PhD dan Postdoctoral diwajibkan memperoleh Letter of Invitation dari dosen pembimbing di salah satu perguruan tinggi anggota ASEA-UNINET di Austria sebelum mengajukan aplikasi.

Sehubungan dengan hal tersebut, kami mohon Bapak/Ibu Dekan dapat menyebarkan informasi ini kepada sivitas akademika di lingkungan fakultas masing-masing, khususnya kepada calon pelamar yang memenuhi persyaratan.

Dear ASEA-UNINET Partners,

In addition to the recently shared call announcements, we would like to share further details with you on the upcoming **Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET (Call 2027/28)**. **We kindly ask for your support** in disseminating information on this call within your (partner) institution(s) among students and staff members!

1. Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET

- a. **Upcoming Call:** A new call will open by 15 September 2026 and close on **1 March 2027**. The call opens only once per year and supports full PhD studies, postdoctoral research stays, and music practice stays in Austria.
- b. **Applications:** To be submitted via the “apply online!” button (available by 15 September 2026) in the [official grant announcement](https://grants.at/en/?=MzUyMzVfMzcxMDNfMw==) [<https://grants.at/en/?=MzUyMzVfMzcxMDNfMw==>]
- c. **Monthly grant rate of 1.300 Euro** (for the Full PhD Grant, the effective monthly grant rate is 1.600 Euro due to the mobility subsidy)
- d. **Changes from the previous call:**

i. **Age Requirement:** The age requirements are applicable for 1 October 2026 (previously for the call deadline)

ii. **Postdoc Grant Duration:** between 4-6 months

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iii. **Research Area:** Research topics in all academic disciplines may be funded. However, the application must highlight the relevance of the research project in relation to both Austria and the ASEAN country. Research projects that focus exclusively on the ASEAN country will not be funded.

- e. **Research Supervisor:** To find a research supervisor (Full PhD Grant & Postdoc Grant), please look for a professor who might support your research stay by browsing the website of any Austrian ASEA-UNINET member university to find an institute or a department that suits your academic profile. It is best to ask professors directly (they are used to such requests). We recommend clearly stating that you are applying for the Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET, and outlining your intended research stay. As obtaining a supervisor's Letter of Invitation is a timely process and as we expect the strong competition from the previous call to continue, we highly recommend initiating contact as soon as possible with the inclusion of a polished research proposal.
- f. **Music Practice Grant:** Audition Process Registration Deadline of 15 December 2026. Information on Scholarship Call 2027/28 (closing date 1st March 2027)

[ASEA-UNINET](#) supports the exchange of knowledge between partner universities and member countries in Europe and South-East Asia. In this context, the network supports the exchange of scientists and postgraduates and the transfer of knowledge associated.

The [Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET](#) offers scholarships for full PhD studies, postdoc research stays and for studies in the field of music practice at an [ASEA-UNINET member university* in Austria](#) to students and researchers **from Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam**.

Citizenship: Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam (only applicants who hold the citizenship of one of these countries are eligible to apply)

Target Country: Austria

Area of Study: All fields of study: Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities

Types of Grants:

Full PhD Grant

Target Group: Postgraduates who want to carry out a full doctorate/PhD-programme in Austria and fulfill the requirements for admission and who have completed their studies at a university outside Austria

Duration: 36 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro + a mobility subsidy of 300 Euro per month

Postdoc Grant

Target Group: Postdocs who are involved in teaching and research at an [ASEA-UNINET member university*](#) in Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam

Duration: 4 to 6 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

Music Practice Grant

Target Group: Undergraduates (or higher) in the field of music practice (instrumental and vocal performance, composition, and conducting)

Duration: 9 months

Grant benefit: 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

Maximum Age: Undergraduates, Graduates and Postgraduates: 35 years; Postdocs: 45 years

Funding Organisation: OeAD-GmbH on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Women, Science and Research - BMFWF in cooperation with ASEA-UNINET

Language Proficiency: Very good knowledge of English and/or German

Selection Process: After an examination of the formal requirements and an evaluation of the applications by experts, the candidates will be invited to a personal (face-to-face) interview. Applicants for the Music Practice Grant have to participate in an audition process including a mandatory interview (for further information see [here](#)). Final decision by the BMFWF.

Closing date for applications: 1st March 2027 (for Music Practice Grant: 15th December 2026)

- Research proposal (in the field of music: CV & Audition Registration)
- Letter of Consent of the supervisor at the Austrian host university (for Music Practice: "Letter of Endorsement" from the Austrian music universities after successful auditions process)
- Two Letters of Recommendation by university lecturers (for PhD applications: a Letter of Recommendation must be provided by an [ASEA-UNINET member university](#)* in Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam or the Philippines.)
- Proof of a very good command of English (B2 or C1, depending on the chosen degree programme)
- Copy of passport
- University graduation certificates as well as an English or German translation.
